IN THE MATTER OF: Lifting a burn ban for the County

WHEREAS, the County of Calloway has experienced extreme drought and windy conditions which have led to extra ordinary fire hazards; and

WHEREAS, wood/brush fires quickly exhaust the firefighting resources of the county; and

WHEREAS, weather forecasts indicate a prolonged dry period with no significant precipitation expected in the county; and


WHEREAS, these conditions endanger the public health and safety and threaten the natural resources of the Commonwealth; and

WHEREAS, the above lead to the issuing of a burn ban for the county effective October 3, 2022.

NOW TEREFORE, I Kenneth C. Imes, Judge/Executive for Calloway County, under the authority vested in me by the Kentucky Constitution do hereby ORDER and DIRECT the following:

1. A temporary lift on all open burning within the County effective 6:00 PM Tuesday, Nov. 1, 2022.
2. The County Judge/Executive reserves the right to reinstate if no more than 3" of rainfall is not received in the next five days.
3. The Calloway County Fire & Rescue is authorized to inforce state and/or federal fire burn laws including the times and locations of burns and can request assistance as may be available to minimize human suffering, restore public services and to alleviate unanticipated financial obligations on state and local government resulting from this emergency.
4. Any person who violates the ban on open burning established in this order shall by subject to penalties provided under KRS 39A.990, and/or such penalties as are provided under state law.

Executed this 1st day of November, 2022 and remain in effect until further ordered.
