

ORDINANCE NO. 96-2
COUNTY OF CALLOWAY, KENTUCKY

AN ORDINANCE OF THE FISCAL COURT, COUNTY OF
CALLOWAY, KENTUCKY CHANGING THE NAMES OF
CERTAIN ROADWAYS LYING AND BEING IN CALLOWAY
COUNTY, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, the County of Calloway, Kentucky is required to provide essential governmental services which includes the implementation and maintenance of the Calloway County Enhanced 911 Emergency Response System.

WHEREAS, on the 8th day of September, 1994, the Calloway County Fiscal Court adopted Ordinance # 94-3, which provided for the implementation and maintenance of the Calloway County Enhanced 911 Emergency Response System.

WHEREAS, in order to ensure the proper implementation and maintenance of the Enhanced 911 Emergency Response System it is necessary that certain roadway names lying and being in Calloway County be changed in order to prevent the duplication of these roadway names. Be it ordained by and for the Calloway Fiscal Court, and it is hereby ordained as follows:

1. That the following roadways lying and being in Calloway County, Kentucky shall henceforth be named as follows:
 - a. See Attachment 1, to this Ordinance with said attachment a being made a part of this ordinance.
2. This ordinance is limited to roadways in Calloway County, Kentucky, lying outside the corporate city limits of the City of Murray.
3. This ordinance shall be take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
5. The Clerk of the Court is directed to publish this ordinance in the Murray Ledger & Times Newspaper one time, to obtain proof of publication thereof and to file said proof in the minutes of this Court.

It was therefore declared that said Ordinance be, and the same is, hereby adopted as the Ordinance Changing the Names of Certain Roadways Lying and Being in Calloway County and that said Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption.
