



### MAIL-IN ABSENTEE BALLOT

Eligible Voters may request a mail-in absentee ballot by visiting [govote.ky.gov](http://govote.ky.gov) available

April 1 - May 2, 2023

#### **Voter process for Mail-In Absentee:**

- Make application on the State Board of Election online portal or call 270-753-3923
- Your ballot will be sent via US mail

#### **Once you receive your ballot packet in the mail:**

- Follow the instruction sheet
- Sign all indicated signature lines
- Mark ballot
- Return in the provided envelope

YOU MAY RETURN BY MAIL OR AT THE DROP BOXES LOCATED OUTSIDE ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF THE COURTHOUSE (MAPLE STREET) OR THE DROP BOX LOCATED INSIDE THE CALLOWAY COUNTY CLERK'S OFFICE 2ND FLOOR 101 SOUTH 5TH ST.

#### REMINDER:

\*Kentucky conducts closed party primaries, you must be registered as a Democrat or Republican to vote in that party's primary election. If you are registered as "Other", you are eligible to vote for only nonpartisan offices (judicial, city commission, school board) in any primary election.

\*Last day to register to vote is April 17th, 2023 to be eligible to vote in the 2023 Primary Election.

### EXCUSED IN-PERSON ABSENTEE VOTING:

May 3rd - May 10th, 2023 between 8am and 4:30pm in the office of the Calloway County Clerk, 101 South 5th St. Murray

NO VOTING ON SATURDAY OR SUNDAY

ELIGIBILITY: PER KRS 117.085, eligible voters must meet one of the requirements:

- Student who resides temporarily outside of his/her county
- Voter or Voter's spouse who has surgery/hospitalization scheduled during Early Voting & Election Day
- Voter who is a resident of KY covered by KRS 117A.010, military member confined to a military base; voter who is a member of the Armed Forces or a dependent of a member of the Armed Forces and will be out of the county on election day
- In last trimester of pregnancy
- Voter who temporarily resides outside the state or overseas but is still eligible to vote in KY
- Age, disability or illness that leads to voter unable to attend Early Voting or Election Day vote centers
- Voter whose employment requires work all days and hours the polls are open during no excuse Early Voting and Election Day
- Election Officers scheduled to work this election cycle
